100% ePAY FAQ

The Association has announced that it is moving to 100% ePay for new and rewrite business.

Here are some of the questions recently received by the Association:

When Is This Effective?

It was announced that this was effective for business submitted on January 1, 2012, or later. In response to suggestions from Producers, it will ***be effective with applications having an inception date of January 1, 2012, or later.*** Many producers feel this would be less confusing.

Will I Need To Complete This Form For Every Insured?

No. The form is used to set up your agency for ePay. The Association will debit your checking account, not the checking account of each applicant.

How Does The ePay Process Work?

You will collect the premium from the applicant and place the funds in the bank account you designated on the ePay sign-up form. When an application is submitted for issuance, the Association will debit the account for the net premium due once the application is approved by Underwriting and issued. The commission amount will remain in your account.

How Do We Get Set Up For ePay?

Go to www.scwind.com and click on the Forms tab. Click on the "ePay Direct Debit Authorization Form" and print it. Fill out the form and mail it to SC Wind with a voided check.
